Child and Young Person Code of Conduct

As a young person taking part in our classes, we would like you to:

- Keep yourself safe by listening to your teacher, behaving responsibly and speaking out when something isn't right
- When you're with us, stay in the places you are supposed to be, don't wander off or leave without telling a member of staff
- Take care of our equipment and the premises as if they were your own
- Make it to class on time and if you are running late, try to inform a member of staff
- Bring the right equipment to class as specified by your teacher and please make sure you are in BB Broadway uniform with appropriate footwear.
- Respect and celebrate difference at BB Broadway and do not discriminate anyone on the basis of gender, race, sexuality, religion or ability
- Report any incidents of bullying, including homophobia and transphobia even if you are just a witness
- Treat everyone with respect and appreciate that everyone has different levels of skill
- Make BB Broadway a welcoming and fun place to be
- Support and encourage your friends, tell them when they are doing well and support them when they are struggling
- Respect our staff and those at the venue in which class takes place

As a young person taking part, we understand you have the right to

- Enjoy the time you spend with us and know that you are safe
- Be made aware of who you can talk to if something isn't right
- Be listened to
- Be involved and contribute towards decision in class
- Be respected and treated fairly by all BB Broadway staff
- Be welcomed, valued and not judged based on your gender, race, religion, sexuality or ability
- Be encouraged to develop your skills and learn confidence with BB Broadway
- Be looked after if there is an accident or injury, and have parents or external help contacted if required.

We expect all children and young people to follow the behaviours and requests set out in this code of conduct. If any young person behaves in a way which contradicts any of the points set out above, we'll address the problem straight away and aim to resolve the issue. Continued breaches of this conduct may result in us regrettably asking you to leave BB Broadway, for the welfare of our children and our staff.
